As the weather indicates, winter is coming our way! Our basketball, wrestling, swimming, diving, bowling and cheer teams are getting ready for action. Schedules and rosters can be found at www.wyomingathletics.org.

The Fall athletic season was one to remember! Our league, the Cincinnati Hills League (CHL), consists of 8 area school districts. This Fall we were champions of the CHL in volleyball, boys' golf, girls' cross country, boys' and girls' soccer, and football.

Additional Fall team and individual accomplishments include:

- Girls' volleyball team winning at 13th straight CHL championship, advanced to the District finals (top 32 teams in the state) and senior Sami Weis being named CHL Player of the Year. Coach Jim DeLong was named CHL Coach of Year.
- Our boys' soccer team finished the regular season undefeated. Steve Thomas was named CHL Coach of the Year.
- Girls' soccer defeated the defending state champion on their way to a CHL Championship. CHL Coach of Year Karen Wood lead the Cowboys to a District Runner Up finish.
- Cross Country once again advanced to the regional finals with the girls' finishing 6th overall and boys' finishing 8th. Seniors Riley Bahr and Jack Schwartz each qualified for state finals.
- Football earned our 6th straight playoff appearance and host round 1 game at press time.
- Boys' Golf won the CHL Championship. Dylan Stevens was named CHL Player of the Year. The boys' advanced to the state finals.
- Girls' golf was crowned District Champions and advanced as a team to the state finals for the 1st time in school history!
- Girls' tennis advanced 5 to the Districts Finals and Peyton Osha and Emily Mayer qualified for state finals.

Wyoming athletics has a proud tradition of excellence and are working daily to ensure we carry on that tradition.
