

**Minutes of the Meeting of the  
Wyoming City School District Board of Education  
Tuesday, December 7, 2021

**I. Call to Order**

Mrs. Zoller called the meeting to order at 7:30 a.m.

**II. 119-21 Roll Call**

The roll was called and the following members were present:

**III. Pledge of Allegiance**

**IV. Discussion: OSBA Capital Conference Session Highlights**

Board members shared information and highlights from sessions attended at the Ohio School Boards Association 2021 Capital Conference. Mrs. Yee highlighted information on mental health needs, restorative practices, mental health community partnerships and equity work. Mrs. Broderick highlighted information on PBIS, restorative practices, equity work, and after school partnerships. Mr. Thomas highlighted school justice partnerships for equity and community engagement. Mr. Buckner highlighted a communications audit and reflections for effective boards. Mr. Weber highlighted social justice/equity in action and personalize learning. Mrs. Johnson highlighted best practices for facility projects and communicating financial information.

**V. Discussion: Resolution in Response to HB290**

Mrs. Zoller, as the legislative liaison, shared that many districts have passed a resolution in opposition to HB290 (known as the Backpack Bill). HB290 allows families to take all computed state funding amounts to the school of their choice. Mrs. Johnson and Mr. Weber discussed the negative impacts of the bill, including using public funds to support private education, limiting the amount of state dollars available for public education, and the significant differences in accountability measures and governance of private vs public schools. The Board agreed in opposition to HB290 and discussed following the progress of the legislation and passing a resolution or using other advocacy tools as needed.

**VI. 120-21 Executive Session**

Mr. Thomas moved to have the Board of Education enter into Executive Session to consider the employment of public employees. Mr. Buckner seconded the motion.

Mrs. Zoller seconded the motion.


