I. Call to Order

VI. Discussion: 2021-2022 School Planning

Mr. Weber shared information on staff vaccinations, including the scheduling of the first dose of vaccines for all staff on Friday, February 12. Group A will receive the second dose on Friday, March 12 and Group B will receive the second dose on Friday, March 5. We will continue to review district COVID data and monitor our ability to comply with our safety protocols. Mr. Weber noted he had been contacted by a Wall Street Journal reporter interested in how we make decisions on our learning mode and he emphasized our reliance on the science of COVID and the expertise of our Science Advisory Team.

Regarding the 21-22 school year, kindergarten registration has begun. We are also surveying our current remote learning families on their feelings for returning to in-person learning for the 21-22 school year.

Mrs. Broderick asked about the current percentage of students who remain remote. Mr. Weber answered that we initially had 75% in person and 25% remote. Mrs. Yee asked about the percentage of staff who chose to be vaccinated and Mr. Weber responded that it is the majority of staff.

VII. Discussion: Consideration for Facilities Committee

Mr. Weber introduced a new Superintendent Committee that would meet regularly to review the state of our current facilities and short and long-term facility improvement goals. Mrs. Johnson added that while facility conversations have taken place in finance committee, alignment with the Business Manager's comprehensive facility assessment and the District's strategic planning work is needed and a facility committee is the appropriate structure for that work. Resource alignment would also be a focus of this committee.

Mrs. Broderick seconded the motion.

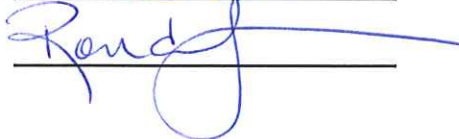
