

**Minutes of the Meeting of the  
Wyoming City School District Board of Education  
Wednesday, November 10, 2021  
Central Office Conference Room**

**I. Call to Order**

Mrs. Zoller called the meeting to order at 7:31 a.m.

**II. 111-21 Roll Call**

The roll was called and the following members were present:

Mrs. Broderick, Mr. Buckner, Mr. Thomas, Mrs. Yee and Mrs. Zoller

Also in attendance Tim Weber, Ronda Johnson, Ashley Whitely, and Suzy Henke

**III. Pledge of Allegiance**

Mrs. Zoller led the Pledge of Allegiance

**IV. Discussion: COVID-19 Pandemic Planning**

Mr. Weber reviewed the various sources of data we are monitoring: community transmission rates, vaccination coverage, screening/testing/ school and district case data, and legislation. The specific data as of November 9, 2021 was shared for Hamilton County, which was a 7.4% positivity rate and 21.7 cases per 100k and 56% fully vaccinated. District case and quarantine data was reviewed, along with updated public health guidance and legislative updates. After review of the data, discussion began on a consideration to change to strongly recommend masking at Wyoming High School and consideration to strongly recommend masking in grades k-8 when specific transmission targets and vaccination targets are met. Board members ask clarifying questions regarding timing and communication and Mr. Weber replied that this discussion will have input on if and when the decision to made to move to strongly recommend masking.

**V. Discussion: Report Card Update**

Mr. Weber and Dr. Whitely led a review of the 20-21 ODE report card. Due the pandemic, grades and rankings were not issued, but the intent was to use the data for recovery and improvement planning. The 20-21 report card included data on achievement (did students pass), progress (did students grow), gap closing (did students in subgroups meet the targets), K-3 Reading (3<sup>rd</sup> grade literacy), and graduation rate (how many graduated), and prepared for success (AP, SAT, CCP, etc.) from the spring, 2021 tests. 20% of Wyoming students were still remote at that time. Dr. Whitely and Mr. Weber discussed how we are using the report card data to identify where we need improvement in curriculum alignment, assessment alignment or a change in instructional practices. Action items at the primary include a systematic approach to identifying skill deficits in literacy and implementing targeted interventions. Action items at the middle school include team meetings to review data, textbook reviews, math lab intervention, math camp and a weekly 5<sup>th</sup> grade science before school intervention. Action items at the high school include rich data conversations reviewing EOC, ACT and AP exam data. Mr. Weber noted that it is critical that we use the data to maximize student outcomes with the non-negotiable outcome of enhancing student growth. Our goals are built around curriculum, assessment and instructional strategies to do this work.

Mr. Buckner seconded the motion.


