**I. Call to Order**

**V. Special Presentations**

Each division highlighted their work from the 20-21 school year in the areas of teaching and learning, climate and culture and communication.

Primary Building Leadership Team – LaDora Hill, Jeff Hicks, Emily LaValle, Jen Dobson, Jenn Fox, Kim Stewart, Ashlee Victor and Marta Stewart shared an update on their 20-21 goals. In the area of teaching and learning, the primary team highlighted personalized learning in a pandemic, efforts to inspire a love of learning, and MTSS implementation. In the area of climate and culture, the primary team shared efforts to value connection and individual needs, connect parents, teachers and students and engage the school community. In the area of communication, the primary team highlighted Canvas integration, Just Because Staff meetings, Attitude of Gratitude Zoom, and S'more Newsletters.

Middle School Building Leadership Team – Jennifer Klein, Michael Anderson, and Beth Smith shared an update on their 20-21 goals. In the area of teaching and learning, the middle school team highlighted creation of a fluid re-entry plan, implementation of zoom for remote learners and Canvas for all learners, transition to 1:1 chromebooks and google, and implementation of various new technology tools. In the area of climate and culture, the middle school team highlighted the use of student data to implement a social/emotional curriculum, the creation of a virtual counseling office and a remote social club and zoom lunches, the revision of extracurricular opportunities, and the creation of regular theme/spirit days for both in-person and remote students. In the area of communication, the middle school team highlighted the use of SchoolMessenger, COVID safe procedures for open house, conferences, course selection and grade-level videos.

High School Building Leadership Team – Adam Reed, Martha Keen and Todd Siler shared an update on their 20-21 goals. In the area of teaching and learning, the high school team re-evaluated the high school schedule, implemented new technology tools including Zoom and Google, created new electives and opened the Dan Jones Center for Research and Innovation to bring lessons to life. In the area of climate and culture, the high school team highlighted start of school celebrations, mental health efforts focusing on students and staff – including launch of Hope Squad, Black History Month celebration led by ACES

and Wyoming Speaks, and hosting in-person events such as athletics, arts, prom, and graduation. In the area of communication, the high school team highlighted the use of Canvas and administrative communication.

The Board of Education reconvened its regular meeting at 11:31 a.m.



**VIII. 59-21 Adjournment**
