

**Minutes of the Meeting of the

I. Call to Order

Mrs. Zoller called the meeting to order at 3:39 p.m.

II. 78-22 Roll Call

The roll was called and the following members were present:

III. Pledge of Allegiance

Mrs. Zoller led the Pledge of Allegiance

IV. Board Work Session

A. Culture Blueprint

Mr. Weber shared a video on the importance of culture and highlighted the recent work in the district focused on culture. He reviewed a draft of the Culture Blueprint which communicates the standards for what we believe, how we behave toward one another, our students and our community. The blueprint was built by a diverse work team (staff representation from all buildings, both classified and certified) and has three beliefs with corresponding behaviors and outcomes and will be shared at opening day with additional professional development to follow throughout the year.

B. Strategic Plan

Mr. Weber reviewed the process that took place over the past year that led to building the strategic plan. He shared the end result which included attributes of a learner (competencies), mission, vision and core values, and five priority areas of the plan. A launch timeline for the 22-23 school year was reviewed and discussed.

The team recessed for a dinner break from 5:20 – 6:20 p.m.

C. 2022-2023 District Goals

Mr. Weber shared the 22-23 District Goals and Actions, adding that building teams are currently planning supporting goals and action steps.

D. Citizens Advisory Committee

The Board reviewed recommendations from the 21-22 study teams in the areas of bullying, primary standards based grading, and primary facilities. Mr. Weber led a discussion on action steps from the recommendations. The Board then reviewed potential study topics for the 22-23 school year and brainstormed questions surrounding potential study topics.

E. Board of Education / Superintendent Committee Planning

Mr. Weber and Mrs. Johnson led a discussion on a timeline for facility committee planning for the 22-23 school year. As a result of the CAC study, a recommendation was made to improve primary facilities and include stakeholders in the decision-making process. The Board discussed beginning that process in the fall of the 22-23 school year and will include evaluating long-term solutions for primary facilities.

F. Being a Board Member Big Ideas

Mr. Weber highlighted big ideas of being a board member. Discussion was focused on the WEA Contract, Wyoming BOE Operating protocols, OSBA Ins and Outs of Boardmanship and positive communication strategies.


Mrs. Yee moved to adjourn the meeting.
