V. **Discussion – Changes in Dress Code – Graduation and Handbook Language**

Dr. Lang and Dr. Whitely led a discussion with the Board regarding potential changes to the senior guidebook and WHS handbook regarding dress code. In response to questions from students and families, the District leadership reviewed the provisions of the dress code related to senior pictures and graduation. Upon review and discussion with legal counsel, the District recommends language that is gender neutral for yearbook photos. For graduation, the requirements remain gender specific but cannot create an undue burden for the student. The senior guidebook and WHS handbook will be modified to reflect the requirement that all female students wear either an all white dress, jumpsuit, or pantsuit that has straps and is floor length, accompanied by white dressy heels or sandals, during the graduation ceremony and all male students wear white tuxedo jackets, black tuxedo pants, and black shoes, the attire received through their school tuxedo rental.

Board members discussed supporting these changes but also expressed a desire to have policy and guidance that continues to uphold Wyoming traditions.
